

## Useful tips for you and your baby

If you come to Leipzig with a baby or small children, you might find this information helpful, since it provides you with a list of places where you can find essentials for your child.

### Milk powder, food, bottles

All of the above can be found at branches of the Rossmann and dm Drogerie Markt pharmacies.

- dm Drogerie Markt can be found on Grimmaische Straße (tram stop Augustusplatz), on Hainstraße, at Wilhelm-Leuschner-Platz (close to the S-Bahn station), on Nürnberger Straße (tram stop: Bayerischer Bahnhof) and inside the main train station.
- Rossmann can be found on Dresdner Straße inside the Kaufland building (tram stop: Reudnitz, Koehlerstraße), on Hainstraße, on Karl-Liebnecht-Straße (tram stop: Hohe Straße, LVB) as well as in the basement of the Petersbogen shopping centre.

### Baby clothes

Spiele Max, Ernsting's Family and H&M all offer baby clothes.

- Spiele Max can be found inside the Höfe am Brühl shopping centre (tram stop: Goerdelerring). They also have an online store.
- Ernsting's Family can be found on Petersstraße and Hainstraße in the city centre (tram stops: Augustusplatz, Goerdelerring or Wilhelm-Leuschner-Platz) and on Dresdner Straße inside the Kaufland building (tram stop: Reudnitz, Koehlerstraße).
- H&M has several stores across the city centre and inside the Höfe am Brühl shopping centre (tram stop: Goerdelerring).

### Pushchairs, baby seats, accessories

Pushchairs, baby seats, etc. are sold at Spiele Max and baby-walz.

- Spiele Max can be found inside the Höfe am Brühl shopping centre (tram stop: Goerdelerring).
- baby-walz can be found on Querstraße (tram stop Johannisplatz).
- Spiele Max and baby-walz both have online stores.

### Where to change and breastfeed a baby

There are several shops and institutions in the city centre which offer a place where you can change and breastfeed your baby.

- The pharmacy Petersbogen-Apotheke offers a small, quiet baby changing room.
- H&M on Petersstraße has a baby changing room with chairs in its children's department.
- The Family Information Office in the Town Hall, on Burgplatz, has a room where you can change and breastfeed your baby.
- The clothing store Breuninger has baby changing facilities next to the toilets on the upper floor.
- There is a baby changing and breastfeeding room in the main train station.

- The university offers baby changing facilities in a number of refectories and cafés:
  - in the childcare area on the first floor of the university campus, just above the main refectory, Mensa am Park
  - in the disabled toilet at the refectory on Peterssteinweg
  - baby changing facilities on the ground floor of the “Mensa am Elsterbecken” refectory
  - in the guest toilets of the refectory on Liebigstraße
  - in the disabled toilet at the café in the GWZ
  - in the guest toilets at the café on Philipp-Rosenthal-Straße
  - baby changing room in the same building as the café on Dittrichring
